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1. WELCOME

1.1. Introduction

Rally Bulgaria is a top event with 40 years of history. From 1970 to 2001 the Rally HQ was located in the famous Black Sea resorts – Zlatni Piasatzi and Albenà. In 2002 the competition moved its base in the central part of South Bulgaria and now takes place in the picturesque resort Borovets, located in the Rila Mountain.

The Rally has total length of 1068,30 km with 14 Special Stages (353,34 km) all in asphalt. Its route is very compact and selective and it passes through the beautiful Bulgarian scenery.

Traditionally, the Rally has very large media coverage and over 200 journalists from Bulgaria and abroad were accredited to the media center. At the same time it received an active support both from the state and the local authorities. The competition was sponsored by big national and international companies.

The Headquarters is located in Rila Hotel in Borovets.

The real charm of Borovets can be sensed in winter time, but in summer the resort offers excellent conditions for holidays too. From 9th to 11th July 2010 Borovets will become the host of Rally Bulgaria and will await and welcome its guests for a first time as part of the WRC event. The shakedown will be held on 7th July 2010. The ceremonial start will be given in the evening of 8th July 2010. The rally goes on for 3 days. There is one Service Park, located in Dolna Banya Airport, some 25 km east from the resort. Borovets is not far away from the capital city of Sofia. It is accessible by plane (Sofia airport is 60 km away) and by road (150 km from Serbian and Greek borders).

4.2. Criteria for acceptance of entries

Anybody wishing to take part in the 2010 Rally Bulgaria must send the entry form, available on www.rallybulgaria.com, duly completed (including co-driver details) to the Rally Office (address given in Art.2.1.1), before the close of entries.

Priority will be granted as follows

- Priority 1 (P1) and Priority 2 (P2) drivers entered by a Manufacturer
- Priority 2 (P2) drivers entered by a Non Manufacturer
- Priority 3 (P3) JWRC drivers
- Non Priority drivers

Manufacturers, WRC Teams and drivers registered for the 2010 FIA JWRC make their entries by using the standard entry form for their championships.

Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee. If the entry form is sent by fax or e-mail, the original entry form must reach the organizer not later than one week after the closing date for entries, on Thursday 3 June 2010 for Manufacturers, WRC Team and JWRC drivers and Thursday 24 June 2010 for other entrants.

Foreign drivers must hold an authorization from their ASN or have its stamp on their entry form.

4.3. Number of entrants accepted and classes

The maximum number of entrants will be 90 cars. If more than 90 entries are received the organizer reserves the right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

5. SERVICE PARK

5.1. Information about the Service Park

5.1.1. Location

During the Rally there will be one single Service Park located at Dolna Banya Airport, 25 km east from Borovets.

All competitors of the Rally Bulgaria will have at their disposal designed areas. Further information will be given in the Supplementary Regulations and RG 2.

5.1.2. Access

Service and Auxiliary plates necessary to access the Service Park are included in the Entry Package that will be given during the reconnaissance sign on. All requests for extra material must be sent to the Rally Office within Thursday 17 June 2010 using the form. Plates must be fixed inside the car, on the right side of the windscreen (co-drive side).

5.1.3. Allocated Service Areas

After the entry closing date, the area corresponding to each competitor will be drawn on the final layout of the Service Park. Competitors who wish to use a joint area with other competitors must request it to the Rally Organiser within Thursday 17 June 2010.

6. TWO WAY RADIO

6.1. Application procedure

Every radio transmitter is subject to licensing. In order to get the license it is compulsory to fill in and send the radio license application form to the Communications Regulation Commission of Bulgaria, with all details about frequency range. The Commission will decide if the requested frequencies can be assigned and will issue a license. The Commission Officials monitor the use of the radio transmitters during the Rally. Unlicensed use of a radio transmitter is forbidden and may lead to prohibition of the use of the transmitter, as well as a fine or the confiscation of the equipment.

7. FUEL AND TYRES

7.1. Fuel

7.1.1. FIA fuel for priority drivers

All priority competitors must use FIA fuel. The supplier appointed by FIA is Petrochem Carless, which has authorised Vital Equipment Ltd. To carry out fuel ordering, supply and refuel services.

The cost of the fuel including taxes and refuel service is 4.63 euro per liter. Competitors must place their fuel order directly to the supplier, no later than Thursday 17 June.

It is a condition of supply that payment must be received in full before delivery. The balance of any unused fuel will be cleared after the rally.

Cars of priority drivers must be fitted with FIA fuel sample coupling, although the FIA reserves the right to check the fuel of any competitor.

7.1.2. Fuel for non-priority drivers

Non-priority drivers may use the FIA fuel, following the same conditions and rules as the priority drivers. For them the use of FIA fuel is not obligatory. As an alternative they will be able to use commercially available pump fuel. The locations of the petrol filling stations will be marked in the road book.

7.1.3. Refuelling

Refuel service will be located at the Service Park in Dolna Banya Airport and at the remote refuel zones as described in the Itinerary (See Appendix 1) and in all road books.

For environmental and safety reasons NO refuelling from cans, drums or similar is permitted within the Service Park.

7.2. Tyres

7.2.1. Supplier

Pirelli has been nominated by FIA as the single tyres supplier for all rallies of the World Rally Championship. All drivers entering a 4WD car or entered in FIA JWRC must use Pirelli tyres as specified in Art.61 of 2010 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations. 7.2.2. Type of tyres

8. RECONNAISSANCE

8.1. Registration procedure

P2, P3 and non-priority drivers: both crew members must be present at the registration as the administrative checks for these categories will be carried out at the same time.

P1 and P2 drivers entered by a Manufacturer or a WRC Team may send a representative (duly assigned by written) to the registration for reconnaissance (administrative check for P1 and P2 drivers entered by a Manufacturer may be carried out by appointment).

At the registration a special form, including details of the car that will be used during reconnaissance, must be signed.

Identification numbers and "R" sticker given at the registration shall be affixed on the car (on front window and on rear side windows) and kept visible for the duration of the reconnaissance period.

8.2. Regulations and restrictions

Crews are authorised to drive a maximum of 2 times through each special stage, but only in the same direction as the rally, at the reduced speed and fully respecting the Traffic Laws. All passages through the special stages will be recorded by the marshals and signed by the competitors. Time cards will not be used.

Maximum speed allowed during reconnaissance on special stage is 70 km/h, unless another speed limit is indicated by traffic signs or by written instruction on the road book or in a bulletin.

Speed control checking devices will be issued. A list of all competitors obliged to fit this device will be issued in a bulletin.

The reconnaissance schedule will be available in the Supplementary regulations.

9. SHAKEDOWN

9.2. Location

Shakedown will take place from Momin Prohod to Gorna Vassilitsa Village, Kostenets. The stage is 2,58km in length. The stage start is 9 km from Service Park. Road book and map will be published in all official road books and in Rally Guide 2.

10. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

10.1. National laws

Competitors coming from European Union Countries do not have to make any customs declaration. All vehicles need to have valid traffic insurance.

Competitors coming from non EU Countries have to report at the customs on their way in.

11. HELICOPTERS

11.1. Registration procedure / information

In order to ensure that air traffic may fly with the maximum safety conditions and according to the FIA Safety regulations and Bulgarian air traffic authority, all helicopters flying over the area related to the Rally Bulgaria during the event, must be registered at the Rally office. Only regularly registered helicopters will be allowed to fly over the Rally area and land in the helicopter area or other sites during the competition.

11.4. Briefing

All needed documentation and all other information will be given during the Pilots' Briefing that will take place in rally HQ on Thursday 8 July 2010 at 20:00. Attendance at the pilots' briefing is obligatory for all pilots. Absence from briefing will imply the cancellation from the registered helicopter list and consequently the prohibition to over-fly the rally restricted airspace. During the briefing all pilots will get three stickers with identification number that must be placed on the bottom and on both sides of the helicopter for the whole duration of the event.

11.5. Refuelling points

Refuelling points will be located in zones selected by the rally organisers and shown in the helicopter book.

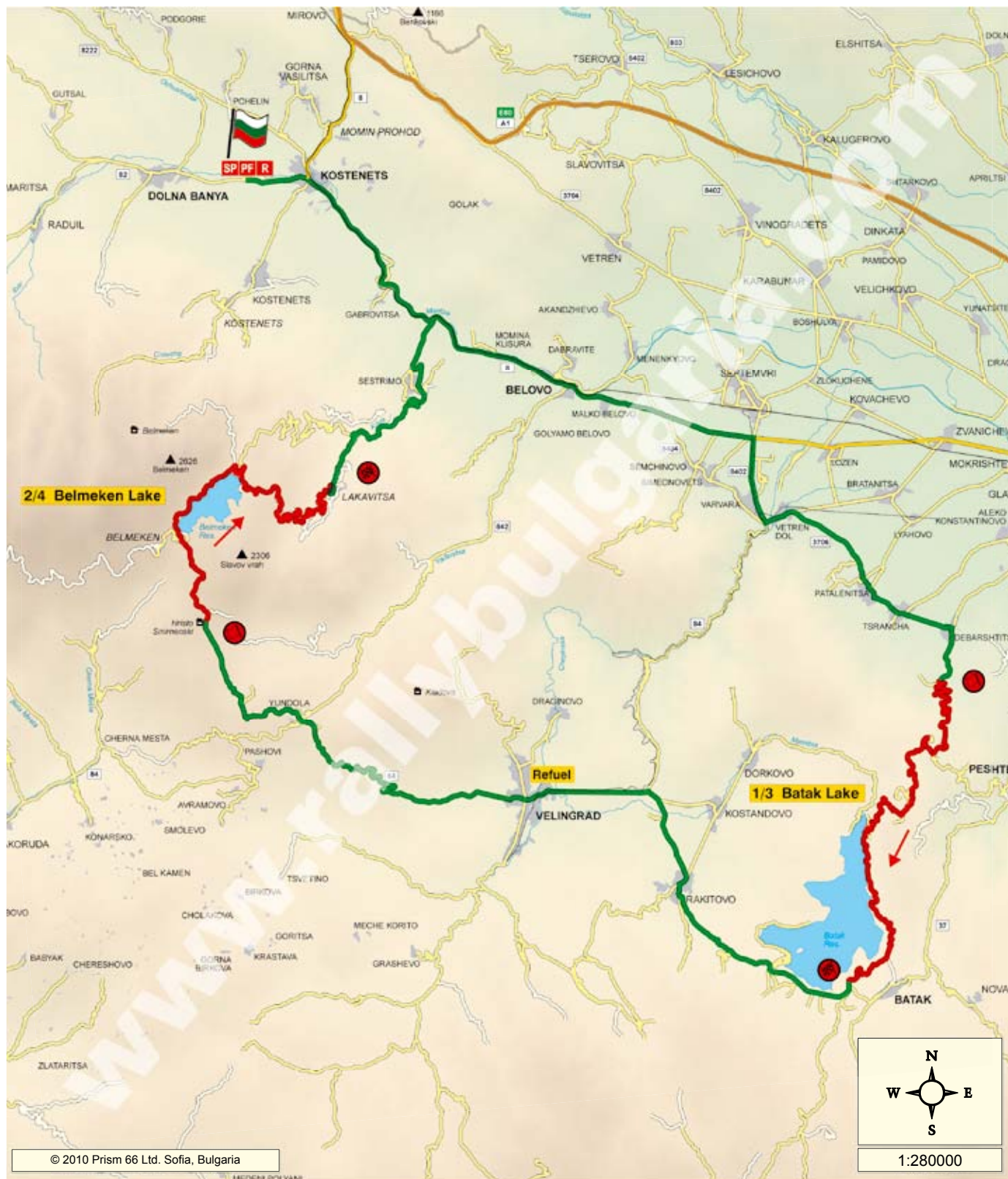
